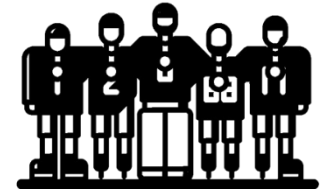
Sign up as a [Free Agent](#) using your USA Hockey membership number

FEES

For the Fall/Winter season league fees are \$5000 per team if paid early, otherwise the team fees are \$5,400. The amount an individual player pays depends on how many skaters that team has rostered. Typically, teams roster 10-15 skaters.

Players must register for an annual membership with the USA Hockey. The annual membership is about \$46 and renews in the fall each year.

EQUIPMENT

Players will need a minimum of the equipment listed below

- Skates
- Helmet*
- Shin Guards
- Hockey Socks
- Gloves
- Stick
- Elbow Pads
- Hockey Pants
- Protective cup
- Shoulder Pads

**Face cages and visors are optional, but are highly recommended.*

PLAYER RANKING

Player Rankings – Each player is ranked on their skill. These descriptions are only guidelines and league administration will have final say on where a player should be ranked.

- Red: This is a broad group of players. This will be the most advanced players in the TAHL league. Typically, Open/Elite Skates and A/B divisions in other market.
- Orange: Examples: Played AA or AAA through Midgets, last played college/juniors/pro and doesn't play to the same level as before. Exhibits strong skating and stick handling skills. Typically, your B/C division in other market
- Yellow: Examples: Played recreational hockey growing up or advanced from novice as playing as an adult. Exhibits basic skating and stick handling skills. Typically, your C/D divisions in other markets.
- Green: Examples: These players could be advancing from beginners or becoming one of our veteran players in the league. Typically, your Recreational divisions in other markets.
- Blue: Examples: New players to adult hockey in other markets. Could be veteran players in the league that played at higher levels earlier in their career.

LEAGUE DIVISIONS

The player rank allowed to be rostered on a team is different for each division.

- Division 1 (Gold): Red, Orange and Yellow ONLY No Green or Blue
- Division 2 (Silver): Yellow and Orange No Red, Green or Blue
- Division 3 (Bronze): Yellow and Green No Red, Orange or Blue
- Division 4 (Rec+): Green and Blue No Yellow, Orange or Red
- Division 5 (Rec): Blue stickers only No Green, Yellow, Orange or Red
- Women's Division: Any level of skill can play in this division
